A big THANK YOU to Billie, Cathy, Dana, and Paula for covering shifts at the store in July. They kept the store running smoothly and more importantly, handled all of the issues that came up so that I could keep my mind on my duties at conference.

Just a "not so sweet" reminder: The consignment booth upstairs **IS NOT** for sold or layaway items. It is a **CONSIGNMENT** booth, and those vendors deserve to have customer access to their items just like you do. The opening to that booth was filled with sold items and layaway items. If it happens again, your items will be put back in your booth. **IF** there is space available downstairs, **AND YOU ASK MANAGEMENT AND GET PERMISSION**, you may put those items in an empty downstairs booth.

**CALENDAR:** The calendar comes out one month in advance. **PLEASE get signed up** on it as soon as you can. **We will no longer accommodate you as a third worker unless all other spots are full!!!** If you haven't signed up by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the current month, we will be getting someone to work your shift and you will owe the \$30. That gives you about 40 days to sign up. We cannot have empty slots, the store is just too busy.

Reminders: (for the newbies and those of you that forget!!!)

- A no-show for your vendor time will cost you a total of \$25.00; \$15 for the shift and a \$10 no-show fee!! If you do not call ahead you will not be allowed to re-book your time, you will need to pay the fee so I can pay whomever filled in for you
- Anniversary rent credit! 10% off your rent during your anniversary month!
- The September work calendar will be out on August 5<sup>th</sup>! Please do not sign up before that day. Staff members have to work around my schedule, so they have to sign up early
- Rent is due on the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month, payable up to the 10<sup>th</sup> and late with a \$10 late fee after that date
- A thirty day written notice is required when you are shrinking down or vacating your booth at the end of the month. The notice **MUST** be to us on or before the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the month you want to vacate. We **DO NOT** pro-rate at the end of your contract!
- Ask the management about the "Finder's Fee" bonus!! Earn up to \$100.00 towards your booth rent
- Please park around the corner or across the street when you are here for more than just a few minutes
