It's time to stock your booths and get ready for the holiday seasons! The real heavy shopping season is beginning soon.

Time for the store bar-b-que!!! We will be meeting at Crest Park on Hilyard Ave. again. Date is September 14, 2011 at 6:00PM. The store will provide the hamburgers, hotdogs, buns, and condiments. Please bring a side dish, salad, or desert to share. You will need to bring your own drinks. See you there!!!!

When you are here doing your time, please be visible to the customers, wear a name badge and be VERY vigilant!!! Pay attention to the customers and what they are doing. Unless you are asked to be at the front to help the staff, PLEASE be on the floor!!! Pay particular attention to the customer that continues to go to the same booth.

Just a note about wrapping items at the counter: Please do not wrap soaps or items that are not breakable unless it is something that may scratch or damage another item in the bag. If there is only one glass item being put in the sack it really does not need more than one piece of paper around it.

If you find you need to raise the price on an item please use a new tag. It looks very tacky to use the same tag. We have had several comments from customers about it.

I know, I know!!!! You've read it all before! BUT>>>Please empty cups before placing them in the garbage, especially the front trash cans. There is a sink in the back and it will save a lot of mess when the trash is taken out.

And speaking about trash, **Thank you!!** for taking your wrappings and plastic sacks home for disposal.

Due to some avoidable issues, we now have a form for you to fill out when you are vacating your booth or shrinking down. And remember, your notice **MUST be received on or before the first day of the month** you will be vacating the booth.

When you have an item that goes on layaway, you may need to leave it in your booth until there is an available space. We will have some empty booths downstairs, (hopefully they will not stay vacant for long!!!) but please ask the staff if you can move your item into an empty booth. They will know if it is rented or going to be vacant for a while.
