A few reminders as the New Year begins:

- Rent is due on the 1st, payable until the 10th, and late with a \$10 late fee on the 11th.
- Please keep your items within your booth parameters. When items are outside the booth parameters, they become a tripping hazard and can easily be damaged by the furniture cart.
- Please remember that <u>all</u> items in your booth need to be tagged. It does not matter if it is a display item or decorations such as greenery etc. please tag them with your vendor number and NFS meaning "Not for Sale". It saves us the time of a phone call! And saves you the grief of items being "sold" with the item they are in.
- We know it is occasionally necessary for you to change tags on items, when you do, **PLEASE** tear the old tags up so we at the till do not think it is an item that was stolen or sold!!!
- Please leave the parking spaces in front for customers, after you unload, please move your vehicle
