Keepers Corner will be holding a Customer Appreciation Sale May 7, 2022. It will be a store wide 20% off everything in the store. As in the past with store wide sales, the 20% will be taken off at the till. When I do the postings, you will see an additional 10% taken off your sales for that day. Keepers Corner is giving up 10% of our commission for the day and you, as vendors, will give up an additional 10% over the commission the store takes. If you have an item you cannot let go for the additional 10% off, you will need to remove it from the store no later than 5 PM on the 6th of May. If you need clarification, please talk to BONNIE. It is the same as if you were having a 10% off sale on your items.

A reminder from the staff; please make sure you remove all yard sale stickers, goodwill stickers etc. when you bring things into the store. It is embarrassing for the staff to have to explain that we cannot sell the item for the \$1.99 you paid at Goodwill. It has cost some of you a sale.

If you sell books, please remember not to tape the price tag on PAPER covers or the pages. We cannot remove those tags without tearing the paper. We recommend paper clips.

PLEASE tag all items in your booth. We are having a lot of items come to the front with no tags. TAGS=MONEY!!! If an item is not for sale, please tag it with your number and NFS (not for sale). We are having someone or "someone's" removing tags. Please, keep an eye on your items for missing tags and retag them.

We have new and newer vendors, (and because those of us that have been here longer forget) so here are some reminders for all of us dealing with contractual items:

- When you vacate a booth, it is your responsibility to vacuum and dust it. It is also your responsibility to keep your booth clean, safe and in a condition that allows complete access to customers and staff
- Please keep your items within your booth parameters. When items are outside your booth, they become a tripping hazard and the furniture cart can damage them
