Take advantage of the time before spring to clean out your booths, check for items without tags and freshen your spaces. It is amazing what a 'new' look can do for sales!

Keepers Corner has made the top five for the Best of the Basin for 2019! Please help us remain #1! We have been nominated in five categories: Two in the Home Sweet Home category- Furniture Stores and Home Decorating Stores. We have also been nominated in three categories under the Shopping heading; Antique and Vintage Stores, Gift Stores and Secondhand Stores. **Please keep your store number one! Vote once a day everyday until February 29, 2020!!!**

TAGS!!! TAGS!!! TAGS!!! Please make them legible. And remember: the vendor number, description of the item and price all belong on the same side of the tag. IF you use an inventory number for your items, that number **MUST** be on the back of the tag. **And please remember no tag, no sale!!**

A few reminders for us all:

- If you put an item on sale, **PLEASE**, do not write on the back of the tag unless you **CROSS OUT** the information on the front
- **BOXES!!!** Yes, we need boxes, but please, do not leave flimsy, display boxes; they are not usable for items and I must dispose of them
- When you vacate a booth, it is your responsibility to vacuum and dust it
- Rent is due on the 1st payable until the 10th and late with a \$10 late fee on the 11th
- **Please keep your items within your booth parameters.** When items are outside your booth, they become a tripping hazard and can easily be damaged by the furniture cart.

The staff wants you to know that "We Love Our Vendors"! And we appreciate you being here! But we do have a few concerns...

1. Please remember that all items in your booth need to be tagged. It doesn't matter if it is a display item or decorations such as greenery etc. please tag them with your **vendor number and NFS** meaning **"Not for Sale"**. It saves us the time of a phone call! And saves you the grief of items being "sold" with the item they are in.
2. We know it is necessary for you to change tags on items once in a while, when you do, **PLEASE** tear the old tags up so we at the till do not think it is an item that was stolen or sold!!!

Great vendors and great customers... what a winning combination...
