**TAGS!!! TAGS!!! TAGS!!! Please make them legible.** And remember: the vendor number, description of the item and price all belong on the same side of the tag. IF you use an inventory number for your items, that number **MUST** be on the back of the tag. **And please remember no tag, no sale!!** If you put an item on sale, **PLEASE**, do not put that information on the back of the tag.

**Please check the back counter for the "GREAT UNTAGGED" items.** When items are found with no tag, we try to keep it on the back counter for a week hoping they are claimed, and then transfer the items to the back room. If you are missing items, please check the list on the bulletin board of places to search and ask a staff member to show you where the untagged are kept.

We know it is necessary for you to change tags on items occasionally, when you do, **PLEASE** tear the old tags up before putting them in the trash so we at the till do not think it is an item that was stolen or sold!!!

**A few reminders:**

- **BOXES!!!** Yes, we need boxes!! But please, do not leave flimsy, display boxes; they are not usable, and I must dispose of them. Please do not leave boxes that are smaller than 12"x12"x5" deep.
- When you vacate a booth, it is your responsibility to vacuum and dust the booth as you vacate.
- **Please keep your items within your booth parameters.** When items are outside your booth, they become a tripping hazard and can easily be damaged by the furniture cart. The edge of the side booth is the end of your booth.
