This is a difficult thing for me to bring up, but it is necessary! Vendors have mentioned that there have been bundles of tags missing from their files. **PLEASE**, honesty really is the best policy.

The Chamber of Commerce December Sip and Shop is Saturday December 5th. We always have great sales from that event. The store gives the shoppers a discount coupon that does not affect your sales. It will be a little different this year. The attendees will not be coming on a bus, they will be coming in smaller groups. There are 50 people signed up to attend.

Just a few reminders for ALL of us:

- There have been some mis-understandings about the Dealer Discount- Dealers in the store and "verified" dealers from other areas and stores can ask for a 10% Dealer Discount on items that are OVER \$50 and have not been previously marked down or are on sale in a booth. Dealers CANNOT take a Dealer Discount in addition to an offer
- We are having a lot of items come to the front without tags or with yard sale stickers. We realize that tags do fall off and sometimes disappear, so please check your stock over every few days. The yard sale tags become a problem and make some customers more than a little angry when they cannot have the item at the yard sale price. PLEASE check your items for unwanted tags!!
- And speaking of tags, PLEASE do not use huge pieces of paper or scratch pad paper as your tag. They are too large to put in the tag bin and creates the possibility of lost tags
- If you are renting a WALL, you are NOT entitled to use the ledge above; that space belongs to the vendor renting the BOOTH
- If you rent upstairs, you most likely have seen the new black markings on the floor. The tape we used when sectioning off the spaces had worn off a long time ago. Scott and I took an afternoon and redid the markings to make them more visible. Please be a considerate neighbor and stay within your rented space.
