Sales for the month of March were \$43,320.90. That is our highest month ever! Our second highest was \$39,096.83 in December 2010. Sales have been phenomenal this year, especially March!!!

We appreciate all of you, and appreciate you being a vendor in Keepers Corner.

Keepers Corner was nominated in 5 areas of the "Best of the Basin". We took 1st Place in Antiques and Vintage stores; 1st Place in Home Decorating Store; 1st Place in Gift Shops; 1st Place in Second-Hand Stores; and 2nd Place in Furniture Stores! You helped make that all possible and to show our appreciation we are giving every vendor a \$20 coupon to spend in Keepers Corner. It is attached to your check.

Keepers Corner will also be holding a **Customer Appreciation Sale** this year. The sale is **May 8, 2021**. It is going to be a **store wide 20% off** everything in the store. As in the past with store wide sales, the 20% will be taken off at the till and when I do the postings, you will see an additional 10% taken off your sales for that day. Keepers Corner is giving up 10% of our commission for the day and you, as vendors, will give up an additional 10%. If you have items you cannot let go for the additional 10% off, you will need to remove them from the store no later than 5 PM on the 7th of May. More info to come.

The good news is we are full downstairs and nearly full upstairs! The bad news is because we are so full, any layaways or sold items will need to remain in your booth until there is space to move them out or they get picked up. Please remember that there are consignment items in several areas of the upper floor, it is grossly unfair for you to block the view or entrance to the consignment items with sold/layaway items. We are calling on the sold items to get them moved out of the store ASAP. Please be patient with the process.

*******EVERYONE!!!*******

Please read these Reminders

- **EVERYTHING** in your booth needs to have a tag! If an item is not for sale, it still needs to be tagged with your vendor number and **NOT FOR SALE**. No TAG, No SALE! Remember; tags=your money!! **AND** a big reminder about tags, **PLEASE** make them legible!!! Hang tags only, no sticky tags, please. It is OK to tape hangtags on wood or glassware or to pin your tags on fabric items.
- Rent is due on the 1st of the month, payable up to the 10th and late with a \$10 late fee after that date.
- A thirty-day written notice is required when you are shrinking down or vacating your booth at the end of a month. The notice **MUST** be to us on or before the first day of the month you want to vacate. For instance, if you want to vacate at the end of May, we must have the notice no later than May 1!!
