We had an issue with sale tags last month. Some vendors have been using the little "dot" tags that have \$1, \$2, etc. on them. A couple of customers have peeled the dot tag off to use on other vendors higher priced items. PLEASE, PLEASE, do not use those little dot price tags to reduce the price your items. I do have some little sales tags that you can use, but I would ask that when you use a sale tag that you write your vendor number as well as the sale price on the tag and staple it to the original tag.

We really appreciate the boxes brought in use for packing customer items, and I know that customers appreciate a box for the glass ware and large and heavy items. But please do not leave boxes any smaller than 12"x12" and around 6+" deep. Please do not leave used newspaper or packing peanuts, or pieces of Styrofoam. we cannot use those items. I just cleaned out the box area and disposed of a very large load of small boxes used newspaper and Styrofoam.

## A few reminders as the New Year begins:

- Rent is due on the 1<sup>st</sup>, payable until the 10<sup>th</sup>, and late with a \$10 late fee on the 11<sup>th.</sup>
- Please keep your items within your booth parameters. When items are outside the booth parameters, they become a tripping hazard and can easily be damaged by the furniture cart.
- Please remember that <u>all</u> items in your booth need to be tagged. It does not matter if it is a display item or decorations such as greenery etc. please tag them with your vendor number and NFS meaning "Not for Sale". It saves us the time of a phone call! And saves you the grief of items being "sold" with the item they are in.
- We know it is occasionally necessary for you to change tags on items, when you do, PLEASE tear the old tags up so we at the till do not think it is an item that was stolen or sold!!!
