There are some empty booths in the store. If you are thinking of adding to, or moving your space, check with the management for available spots!!!

Parking in front of the store should be reserved for customers. If you need to park in front to unload stuff, please park your car across the street or down the street as soon as you are unloaded. This also pertains to your work days.

We will be having the "Anniversary Sale Day" on Saturday, May 3, 2008. This will be after a payday, but before Mother's Day. It will be 20% off all items in the store. As before, Keeper's Corner will absorb 10% of the sale price. Attached is an information sheet outlining the procedures for the day.

Reminders:

- **Correct tags are money in your pocket!!!! Check the till for no ID/wrong ID tags**
- **A thirty day written notice is required when you are vacating your booth at the end of the month. This applies when you are leaving after your initial six months OR at any other time after your 6 month commitment is over**
