When you vacate a booth, please vacuum the floor for the next vendor. Please remember that the responsibility to keep the store clean belongs to all of us. If you see a spill or a mess on the carpets, please clean it up, or notify the front staff so they can get on it.

Staff Concerns: The staff wants you to know that "We Love Our Vendors"! And we appreciate you being here!

1. PLEASE, do not use dark colored paper for your tags. They are extremely hard to read.
2. And again, please write legibly on your tags, and if you put a lot of information on the tags, please consider using larger tags.
3. Remember that the displays are managed displays. Ask Linda or other staff members before putting your items in the displays.
4. It would be greatly appreciated if when you remove your file from the boxes to check sales that you put the files back in numerical order.
5. Please use extreme caution when bringing items down the ramp! There is getting to be a lot of wear and tear on the bannister posts.
6. When you are restocking your booths, please be considerate of customers as they shop and sales staff as furniture is moved out!
